



The Truth Is Out There

Game

Session 2

Buy two model aeroplanes and take the instructions out. Split the group into two and get them to connect the aeroplane together. The winner is the first team to do it.

Point: -

It is difficult if not impossible to live our lives without the Maker's instructions. For a Christian, the Maker's instructions are found in the Bible.

Discussion

Divide the group into threes. **Cut out** the six cards from the attached sheet. **Give the** group the first set of six cards.

Ask the question, "What is most likely to stop you reading the Bible?" **Each card** is given marks out of ten for how likely it is to distract them from reading the Bible. **Get them** to discuss the top three and try and sort out how they can deal with these distractions.

Give each group the other six cards asking the question, "What is most likely to encourage you to read the Bible?" **Get each** group to say what their top card is and why!

Fact file

Give out copy of Fact File to each member of the group. Let them work in small groups to answer the questions then feed back the answers to the larger group at the end.

Activity

How to Use the Bible!

Explain to the Young People how the Bible works. **Points** to be made:-

- ☺ Contents page at the front of Bible to help find the books.
- ☹ The Bible is made up of Two Testaments – The Old And the New
- ☺ The large numbers are the Chapters
- ☹ The small numbers are the Verses

Give each one of them a Bible – read out some Bible passages and see which one of them is the fastest. **Give a** small prize to the winner!!

Main Point:-

By reading and obeying the Bible we make our faith stronger. **We learn** how to live to please God and we are able to share our faith more effectively with others.
