

Even the circumstances of his death and the impact of his trial – followed by the claims of over 500 people who testified that he had risen from the dead and that they had seen him after his death. All of these events and hundreds more paint for us a portrait of a man who was God.

Jesus' Actions

When we look at Jesus' actions we get a visible demonstration of the invisible God at work. In every sense Jesus reveals to us the love of God in action. From healing the sick – to caring for the outcasts, from feeding the hungry – to raising the dead. Jesus showed the compassion, supernatural power and authority of God at work. His ability to look into people's hearts and satisfy the spiritual hunger of people, clearly supports Jesus, claim to be God.

Jesus' Words

Jesus spoke some of the greatest words that have ever been spoken. His words have shaped nations, changed billions of lives and have had a lasting and universal effect.

So what did Jesus say about Himself?

We have seen something of the amazing life and impact that Jesus has had, but the question is who did Jesus claim to be? and by looking at his life can we trust his claims?

Many times Jesus personally testified that he was God. (ask them how they would feel if you started to claim you were God himself – The same goes for Jesus either he was a nutter or what he said was true!!)
On a number of occasions he said “ If you don't believe my words then look at the miracles and actions I do!”

What the Bible says:-

Here are a number of times Jesus testified to be God:-

Mark 14 v 61 – 62

“ Again the high priest asked him, “ are you the Christ, the Son of the Blessed One?” “ I Am,” Jesus replied, “ and you will see the Son of Man sitting at the right-hand of the Mighty One and coming on the clouds of heaven.”

“ I and the Father are One whoever has seen me has seen the Father.”

“ I am the Way and the Truth and the Life, no-one comes to the Father except through me.” John 14 v 6

So the question is who is Jesus and how should we respond to him? He cannot be a good, moral teacher and a liar at the same time!! He either is who he says he is the Son of God, or a liar.
