

Who do you say Jesus is?

Game:- Who am I?

Write names of famous people or fantasy figures i.e. Father Christmas on a small piece of paper or card in the form of a label.

Objective:- To guess who you are

Instructions:- Stick a label to each group member's forehead but don't let them see what name is on it. In a circle take it in turns to ask questions to the rest of the group that will help to determine what name is on your forehead, i.e. Am I male or female? The winner is the one who guesses first. Carry on until all are revealed.

Point:- To show the group that we need to ask questions if we want to find out who someone really is or was.

Discussion:-

Using the chart provided (*copy on to white board or enlarge as necessary*) ask the group to tick the box that they think Jesus was/is. Add up the results and ask the following questions.

Why did you tick the box that you ticked?

If God became a human what would He do? / What would He look like?

Visual Input:-

Use the pre-recorded video provided. Show the clip of the Jesus video. *Play music in the background from a Christian band that talks about Jesus.*

Talk:-

Use the acetates provided to explain the life of Jesus.

Acetate 1: Fact or Fiction

Acetate 2: Jesus' Life

Acetate 3: Jesus' Actions

Acetate 4: What Jesus said about Himself

Acetate 5: Who do you say I am?

Challenge:-

Ask one leader to give a short testimony and then go back to the "Who do you think Jesus is?" board used in the discussion. Ask the group if they want to change their tick.

MAIN POINT:-

Jesus was a man who existed in history but was also God.
