

# What has Jesus done for us?

## Game:- Who's gonna pay?

Split the group into pairs. Select one person from each pair to try their luck on a game which involves lots of opportunity for mistakes, i.e. a steady hand puzzle.

**Objective:-** To avoid making your friend pay for the things you do wrong

**Instructions:-** Every time the person in control of the puzzle or game makes a mistake their partner is punished, i.e. egg them or make them eat a pickled onion.

**Point:-** The person who took the punishment is like Jesus. When He died for us he took all the wrong things we do on His shoulders and now we can be forgiven and set free.

## Discussion:-

Using the Flash Cards provided split into groups of three and discuss the 8 facts about Jesus. Ask the group what they feel about each one.

## Visual Input:-

Use the pre-recorded video provided. Show the clip of Armageddon. – Where Bruce Willis stays behind to detonate the bombs. Dies to have all of humanity.

Ask the group what they think of the man dying in the place of someone He loved.

## Talk:-

Prepare a bowl of slime or something gooey, put a pound coin at the bottom. Ask for a volunteer to come forward and put their hand in the slime to find a gift (the coin).

Explain that Jesus came down to earth into all the slime and wrong doing in the world to die for us. Jesus was our gift from God to free us from sin, death and so that we might be cleaned up in a way that allows us to come back to God..

Using the final two acetates explain that Jesus died for us and that we need to decide whether to walk across the bridge and follow Him or not.

## Challenge:-

Show a video of Jesus crucifixion. During this time play some soft Christian music in the background.

## MAIN POINT:-

**Jesus came to earth took on all the wrong doing and dirtiness of the world to die for us on the cross, He died for our sin, died our death – So that through faith in Him we might be forgiven and restored back to God.**
